Dear Applicant,

In an effort to foster a desire to better the caliber of mariners employed on the Great Lakes, the GLCA is offering an annual scholarship or "honorarium" to encourage fellow mariners to get the training they may need to obtain an original license or upgrade an existing one. This honorarium will be known as the "GLCA Hawse Pipe Scholarship", and will be presented to a qualified individual, in January of each year.

Approval and payment will be dependent upon consideration of a completed application, financial need, and final approval of the Board of Directors of the GLCA, at the time of application.

Payment of all or a portion of the costs incurred shall not exceed \$500.00, and shall be payable to the institution or organization offering the course or training, after proof of successful completion has been submitted to the Board of Directors of the GLCA.
